

**Home Health Aide Program #SA-HHA101**

A Home Health Aide (HHA) performs a variety of services for a patient in his or her home. Such duties as helping the patient self-administer medications, meal preparation, and assistance with bathing and toileting are tasks that the Home Health Aide may be asked to perform. To be trained as a Home Health Aide, students must complete 40 hours of classroom and hands-on lab training, with at least sixteen hours devoted to supervised hands-on practical training. At the completion of the training, participants will receive a Certificate of Completion.
