

**Private Security Officer Training Program # DCJS 01E, License

This Department of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS) Private Security class is a 75-hour training program designed to prepare unarmed security officers and alarm respondents to obtain employment in corporate and government settings. Classes cover topics such as Virginia law and regulations, ethical standards, professional conduct, controlling access, crime prevention, probable cause, and due process. Students will learn methods of directing persons causing a disturbance to leave property, conducting escorts as required, examining vehicle contents as required, inspecting perimeter structures for damage and/or forced entry, etc. Defensive Techniques will also be covered. Students are required to register with the Department of Criminal Justice Services and be fingerprinted. There is a written examination at the end of the class; however, there is no examination fee. At the end of this class the student will receive a Certificate of Completion and be eligible to apply for DCJS registration as a Private Security Officer.
